

## HEAVY RIGID TRUCK OPERATOR SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSE

This course is designed to align with Australian standards, and trains Drivers in all facets of the operation of a Heavy Rigid Truck, which is classified as a vehicle with a gross mass over 8,000kgs, and has 3 or more axles. With a main focus on safety and awareness, this course is suitable for semi experienced drivers.
